July 12th, 2013: QRRRWNL membership renewals are coming due - and this year, we're very pleased to announce that we've made some **significant improvements** to our membership system.

We now have an **integrated online portal** where new members can join up at any time, and existing members can **renew their membership** or **check their account status** any time they like too.

We've been working on developing an online "back end" system for the QRRRWNL for some time.

Why? Because it's **better, more convenient** and **faster** for our members than the paper-based systems we've been using until fairly recently. And (all things considered) it's more **cost-effective** overall too.

Naturally, we know that there are still a few members out there who **aren't** online. And to ensure they suffer **no disadvantage**, we're still happy to process paper-based forms through our new system on their behalf.
